Sensory Room Appeal

The Children's Centre staff are currently trying to raise funds to refurbish the Sensory Room.

The room was originally set up in the Spring Street Family Centre about 15 years ago, after moving to Butler's Hill and Broomhill Children's Centre the old equipment was transferred with it.

The Sensory Room is very popular with families and is currently used by children of all ages from being babies up to 11 years old. The Sensory Room is also used by the Rocking Horse Day Nursery, schools in the Hucknall area and also by Sutherland House in Ravenshead which is a specialist school for children with autism.

The current contents of the Sensory Room include: fibre-optic lights, a projector, a disco ball, rope lights, stereo, a soft play floor and a bubble tube. Most of these items are either broken or looking very worn. It is difficult to replace parts of the equipment due to their age.


We are currently looking at raising £3000 so that we can replace some of the current equipment and hopefully buy new equipment.

We have already raised £260 from donations of parents using the Sensory Room, a donation from Kids Plus and also from a member of staff stopping smoking.

Staff from the centre recently completed a sponsored bike ride cycling from Hucknall Market Place to Newstead Abbey and back on 15th September and are awaiting information on total amount raised from this event. As a centre we have more fundraising events planned for the near future.
