CORROSION PROTECTION

As you all know I now have the Lincolnshire Franchise for All Year Biker, a specialist anticorrosion system designed specifically for bikes. We all like our pride and joy to look clean and shiny don't we? Is that the only reason that we spend time cleaning and polishing them? I guess most would say yes, but the real reason is that it protects your bike from corrosion. Only ride in the summer? Salt remains on the roads for weeks after it's been applied and even summer roads are covered in contaminants, animal faeces, brake dust, exhaust particulates, spillages from vehicles and overspray from agricultural applications. All these get on your bike and when moisture is added can cause chemical reactions that cause corrosion. So the real reason for cleaning your bike is to prevent corrosion.

Taking a methodical and systematic approach to cleaning your bike will make the process easier and more effective.

1. Pre-rinse: This removes loose dirt and re-hydrates heavy deposits making the shampoo more effective.
2. Apply the cleaning product. These are designed to do just that don't scrub at the dirt as that can damage the surface you are cleaning. Apply the product agitate lightly and allow time for it to work. Start with heavily soiled areas first wheels and engine then move onto the bodywork. Use a long handled soft brush to agitate the cleaner and keep it moist. Rinse your brush before moving from heavily soiled areas to more lightly soiled areas.
3. Rinse off the dirt and shampoo. This is the most important stage all shampoo and cleaner needs to be thoroughly removed. Check regularly with your finger if the surface feels slimy rinse further.
4. Dry the bike either with a good quality drying cloth or with an air dryer.
5. Apply a good quality wax to painted surfaces as per the manufacturer's instructions.
6. Apply corrosion protector such as ACF50 to metal surfaces this is best applied with a cloth as aerosol cans put too much on a leave a messy finish.

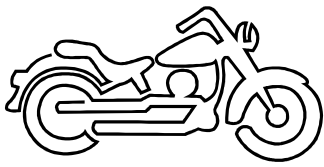
