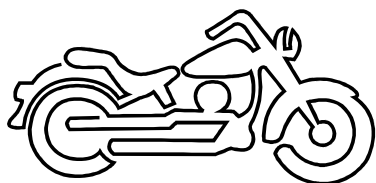
East Kirby Aviation Centre Bike Night is on Wednesday 15 June. If you haven't been before it's well worth a visit. £5 per bike.
